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Key Stage 4 – Years 10 & 11

GCSE Design and Technology: Graphic Products enables students to design and make products with creativity and originality, using a range of graphic and modelling materials. Students will be enthused and challenged by the range of practical activities. They will be encouraged to learn to use, understand and apply colour and design through images, to develop spatial concepts and to understand graphic materials and their manipulation. They will design and make products(s) using graphic media and new technologies to prepare them for the world of work.

Assessment:

Written Paper: 40% 2 hour written examination

Controlled assessment: 60% (a 30 hour design, make and evaluate task)

Progression:

For students who wish to develop their studies further, A-level Graphics Technology and other related courses are available. A qualification in Graphics Technology can lead to a variety of different pathways and careers, which offer exciting opportunities.
