



**Catch up Plan for Year 7 - 2020 Cohort**

Area of highest need:

- 38 pupils = NGRT reading age of between 5:0 and 7:0 years and/or English Language GCSE prediction between 2 and 3
- 30 pupils = Maths GCSE prediction of 2 or under

Already in place for some of these pupils:

- Lowest ability 15 pupils are enrolled on Read Write Inc - English lessons - 7 per week x 90 minutes
- Lowest 25 are also enrolled on a daily Lexia intervention during form time - numbers to be made up to 60 from lowest ability maths pupils - will then alternate Lexia and Maths Watch intervention daily
