Dear Parents and Carers,

Our immunisation teams deliver the COVID-19 vaccination programme across Hertfordshire and East Anglia and they have been working extremely hard, to vaccinate as many eligible, 12–15 year-old children as possible.

Over half term, week commencing Monday 25 October through to Sunday 31 October we have opened dedicated appointments at a variety of community-based vaccination sites across the region. These appointments must be pre-booked using the following [weblink](#). These clinics are being added to, so please revisit the link to find more options throughout next week.

Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate walk-in appointments. You should bring identification of your child, and their NHS number and give consent for them to be vaccinated.

Alternatively, in the next few days it will also become possible to book appointments for your child at the majority of our large-scale vaccination centres across the region, via the National Booking Services, either at www.nhs.uk/covidvaccine or by calling 119.

You may also wish to wait until our teams come to vaccinate your child at their school. If this date hasn't yet been arranged, our team will be in touch soon to advise when we are coming.
